

Protection Sequence

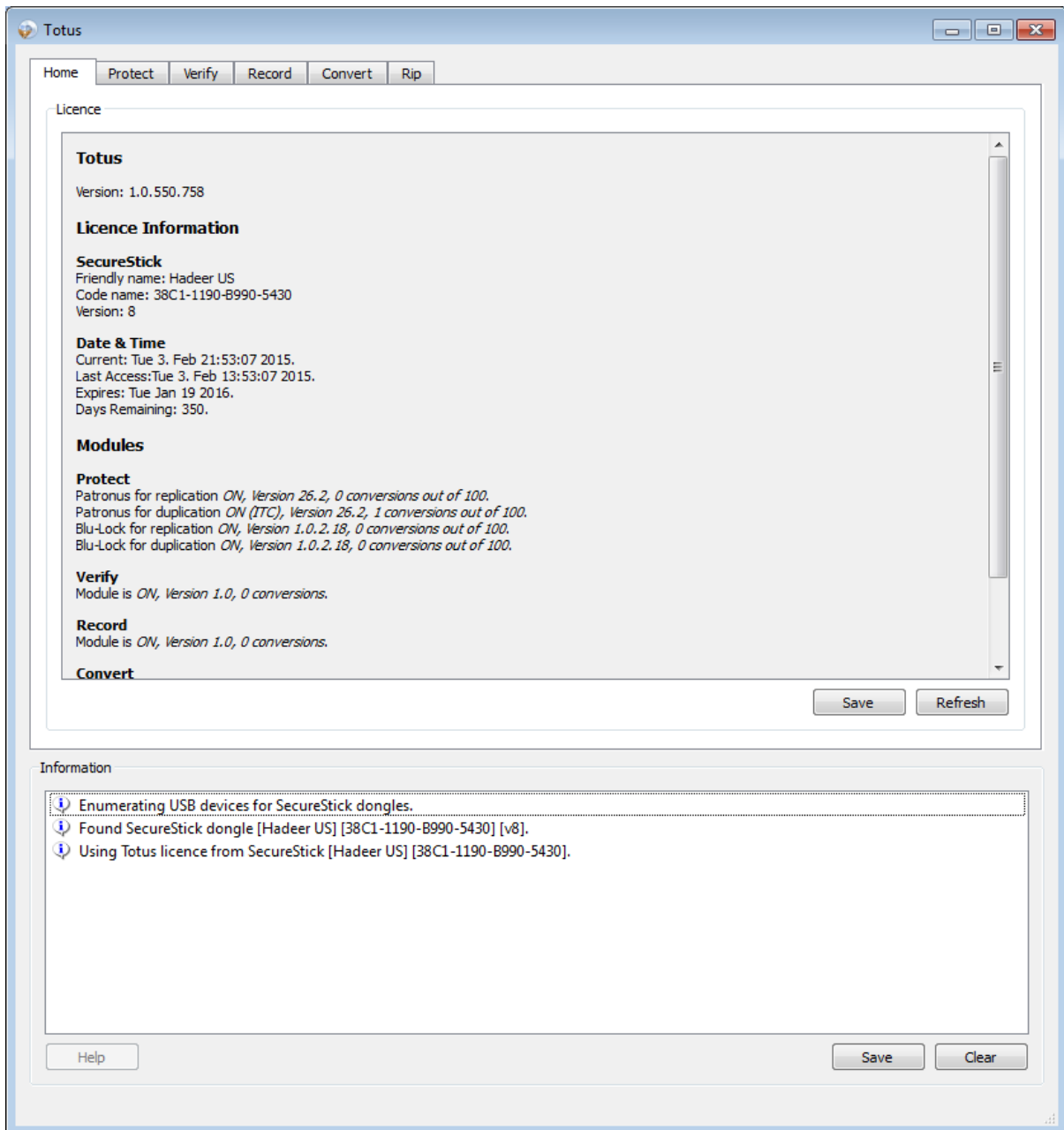
Definitions:

ISO – Image file which contains all the video data. This is the actual image that burns onto the disc.

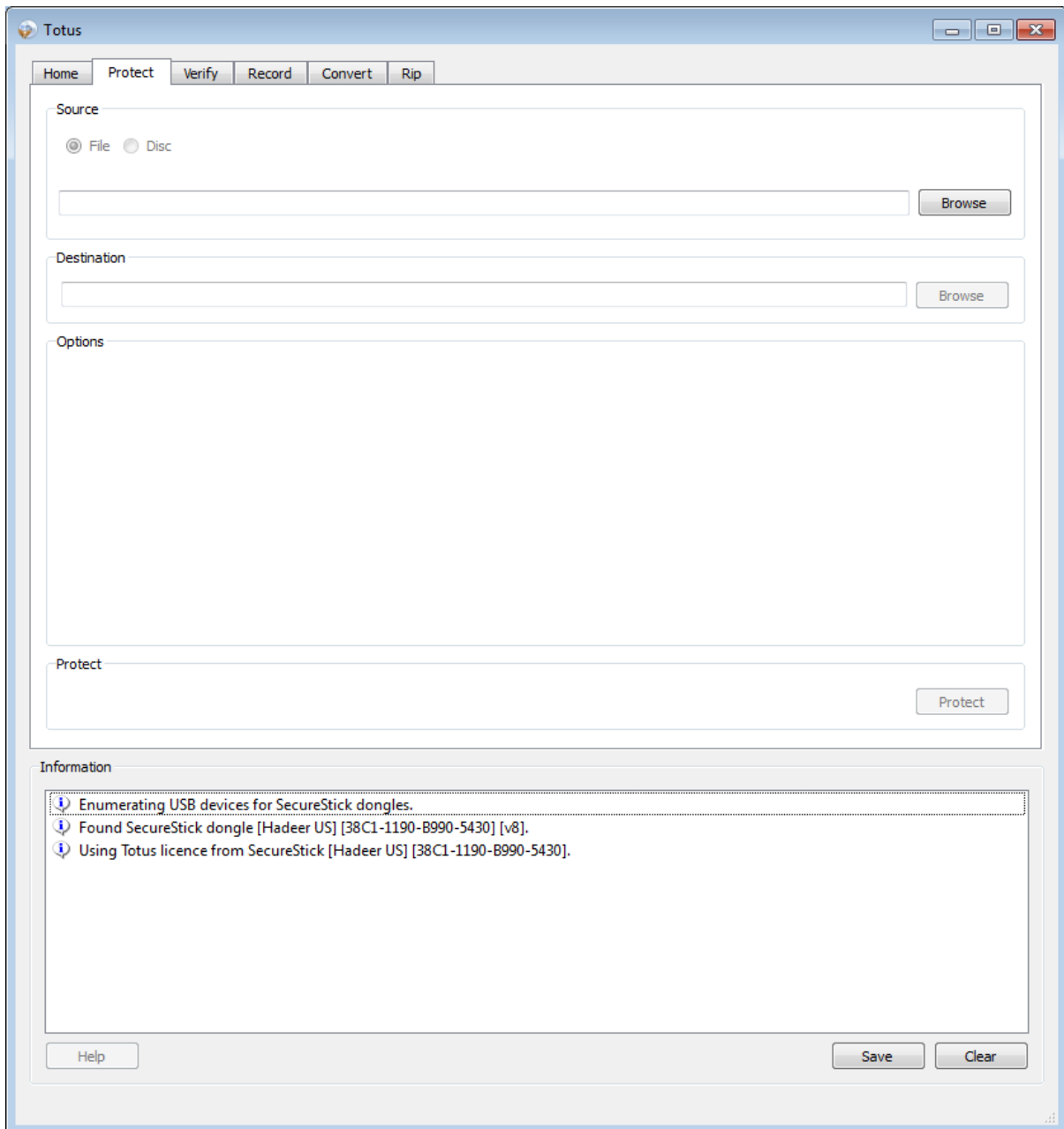
Optical media – Physical discs (DVDs)

Follow the steps to produce a copy protected Disc:

- 1) Launch Totus



Click on the **Protect** tab



Click on the **Browse** in the Source section of the program and select the ISO file you would like to protect with Patronus.

Click on the **Browse** in the Destination section of the program, then type in a name for the newly produced and protected ISO which will be placed in the destination path you selected.

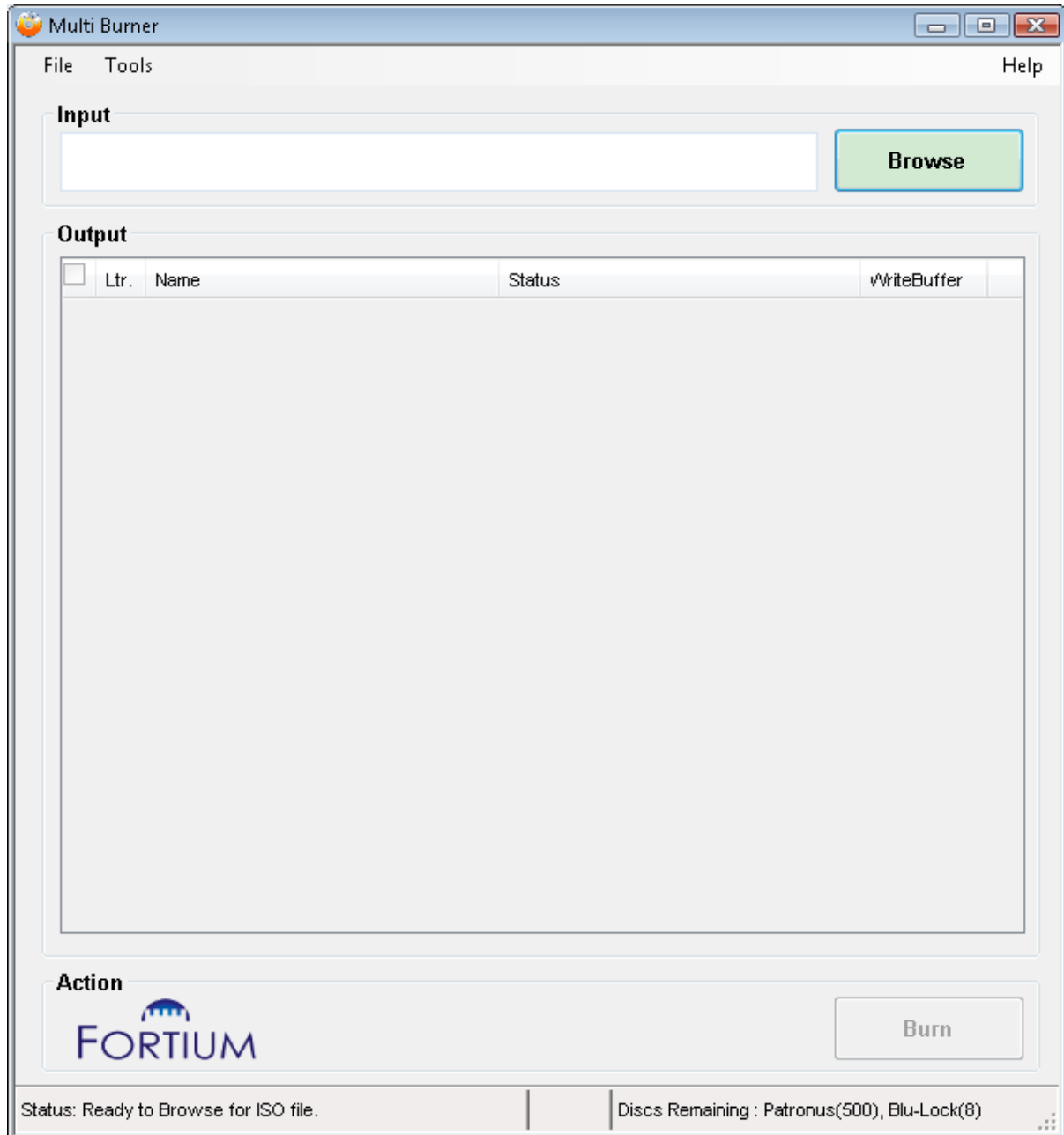
Click on **Protect** to start the protection process which produces a protected ISO.

Once the operation is complete, please click **Finish**.

2) Launch Multiburner

In this example we will use Multiburner to burn the protected ISO onto optical media.

Insert your blank optical media into the optical media drives ready for burning.



Click on **Browse** and select the protected ISO file you protected in the previous step.

Select the available tick boxes (each tickbox will correspond to an available optical media drive).
Selecting the top level tickbox will select all available drives.

Select **Burn** to proceed with the burning process. Wait for the burning process to complete, which may take a while. Once done successfully, you can eject your discs and they should be fully protected.
